Powerwheels Races are open to any child 3 to 9 years old. Unmodified battery powered vehicles are raced head to head with up to ten other racers. Volt classes will be created if there are enough vehicles to participate. Trophies are awarded to the winners and ribbons to all who participate. Powerwheels races are used as filler between other race events and intermission. Event management will post an approximate time but please have your racers vehicle on hand in the race area at least 1 hour before posted time. A bike or motorcycle helmet is recommended.

Event Management has the discretion to permit or deny individual(s) from participating in Activities at its own discretion.

Event Management MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR EXPRESS IMPLIED WARRANTIES THAT COMPLIANCE WITH THE RULES AS WRITTEN OR ANY ADDENDUMS TO THOSE RULES WILL GUARANTEE AGAINST INJURY OR DEATH, OR DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY. These rules and regulations constitute the minimum standards for Activity and are intended as a guide for the conduct of the Activity. The primary responsibility for safe participation is with the parent or guardian of the participating child. Management reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. Failure to abide by these rules is grounds for disqualification and possible removal from the TrailRex event.

Some Activities are inherently dangerous. Children should take part in these Activities based on parent or guardian's assessment of child's abilities. If parent or guardians have not personally inspected the Activity area, we urge you to do so.

The promoter does not provide medical insurance coverage. We urge you and your child not to participate in activities without adequate personal medical insurance coverage. If you have any doubts at this time about your personal or child's abilities to participate in this Activity, if you have not adequately prepared yourself, your child, and your equipment, or if you believe your personal insurance coverage's are not adequate to compensate you for any loss that might occur, we urge you to notify the promoter who will refund your entry fee.
