Motor vehicle mishaps, in competition or otherwise, can result in injury or death. Motor vehicles should never be used by minors without parental consent or supervision. Your entry fee is fully refundable if you find the course unsuitable for your abilities or equipment.

The Event Management will make reasonable efforts to insure that venue rides are enjoyable and as safe as possible. Although there are inherent risks associated with riding OHV's, a few rules will help to minimize unfortunate incidents.

Mandatory 10PM Curfew on ALL Riding, keys out or you're out!

1. Event Management has the discretion to permit or deny individual(s) from participating in venue riding at its own discretion.
2. Helmets are **required** to be worn by all riders and will be enforced.
3. Suitable riding attire is recommended such as proper footwear and properly fitting clothing that is specifically appropriate for the weather conditions. Loose and billowy clothing is not recommended, nor is it safe.
4. Vehicles of a proper size and power for the rider's size and ability are required so as to properly be able to traverse terrain. We recommend following the Manufactures recommendations. **For your own safety and the safety of the rest of the riders and spectators, riders who are on a grossly inadequate or overpowered vehicle for the conditions may be denied permission to ride at the discretion of Event Management. Event registration will be refunded if event rules were not broken.**
5. It is the sole responsibility of the RIDER to ensure that you are following New York State regulations as it pertains to registration, insurance, compliance, and the carrying of required documentation. The TrailRex liability insurance requires the participating riders' compliance with off road vehicle regulations. **When signing the Waiver of Liability, riders must show proof of insurance and identification. All venue riders must be at least 16 years of age.**
6. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not permitted. Intoxication while riding will result in immediate removal from the property with no refunds and possible barring from all future events.
7. Riding "2-Up" on a single rider OHV is discouraged as it can be unsafe, particularly in steep up-slope, down-slope, and off-camber situations.
8. These rules can be changed by Event Management at any time in the effort to create a safer riding opportunity or general event functionality.

As you know it only takes one person to destroy opportunity for us all. This event will have a high volume of traffic, use your head and remind others of these rules where appropriate. Some mistakes we don't get a second shot with so protect the opportunity we have to share good times at an event like TrailRex.

These rules and regulations constitute the minimum standards for competition and are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport. The primary responsibility for safe condition and operation of racing vehicles in competition rests with the vehicle owner and driver. Management reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. Failure to abide by these rules is grounds for disqualification and possible removal from the TrailRex event.

Motorsports are inherently dangerous. You should take part in this riding based on your own assessment of your abilities. If you have not personally inspected the ride area, we urge you to do so.

You have been provided an opportunity to ride under noncompetitive conditions. You are responsible for the quality and condition of your ATV and protective apparel.

The promoter does not provide medical insurance coverage. We urge you not to ride in Motorsports activities without adequate personal medical insurance coverage.

If you have any doubts at this time about your personal abilities to participate in this event, if you have not adequately prepared yourself and your equipment, or if you believe your personal insurance coverage's are not adequate to compensate you for any loss that might occur, we urge you to notify the promoter who will refund your entry fee. Spectators witnessing these events thereby assume all risks for any injuries or damages resulting there from.
